Join your fellow Newark Museum members for our *annual* New Year's holiday trip. This year: **Portugal** where we spend five nights in its captivating capital. **Legendary Lisbon**, with over 20 centuries of history, has blossomed into a cosmopolitan city called by Fodor's an alluring combination of sunny skies, glorious architecture, deep-rooted traditions, and a thoroughly modern flair. Set on the Tagus River, it is filled with narrow cobbled stone streets and medieval tile-covered buildings that contrast with its modern architecture. Lisbon's position on seven low hills beside a river once lured traders and settlers, and it's still a stunning site. Add to that its cultural diversity, laid-back feel and architectural time warp, and you have one of the most enjoyable cities in Europe. At Lisbon's heart are wide, tree-lined avenues graced by Art Nouveau buildings, mosaic pavements and street cafes. Seen from the river - one of the city's many great viewpoints - **Lisbon** is an impressionist picture of low-rise ochre and pastel, punctuated by church towers and domes.

### **THURSDAY, DECEMBER 27**

Our non-stop **United Airlines Flight Number 64** departs Newark Liberty Airport at **8:20PM**. Dinner is served on board.

### **FRIDAY, DECEMBER 28**

We arrive at Lisbon's Portela Airport at **8:10 AM** and begin our visit with a **panoramic tour** of the city. You'll see the 16<sup>th</sup> century **Belem Palace**, residence of Portugal's president. Nearby is the **Jeronimos Monastery**, the most impressive symbol of Portugal's power and wealth, where Vasco da Gama and his crew spent their last night before leaving on his exploratory trip to India. After lunch we check-in to our hotel, **NH Collection Lisboa Liberdade**, for a five night stay. This welcoming 4 star hotel with modern amenities is ideally located in the center of the city. We have dinner tonight at the hotel.

### **SATURDAY, DECEMBER 29**

After breakfast, we begin our day stepping back in time in the **Alfama District**. This village within a city is made up of narrow cobbled streets, tiny squares, churches, and whitewashed houses with wrought-iron balconies. There is a flea market and the **Old Jewish Quarter**, one of the oldest in the city. At the top of the area, **Castelo de São Jorge, Saint George's Castle**, can be seen from almost everywhere in the city. Its oldest parts date from the 6th century.

After lunch we tour the **Berardo Museum**, one of the world's most acclaimed modern art collections, with works by Warhol, Picasso, Dali, Duchamp, Magritte, Miró, Bacon, Jackson Pollock, Jeff Koons, among others representing dozens of modern movements. It was amassed by Portuguese magnate Joe Berardo, who for many years had wanted to create a museum for his vast collection. Cities like Paris and Miami were interested in acquiring it, but the Portuguese government made sure it stayed in Lisbon and in 2007 agreed to provide space inside the Museu Coleção Berardo to provide a space for the very best of modern and contemporary art. The museum features a permanent collection and a series of regular temporary exhibitions that showcase a diverse range of contemporary artists. Museu Coleção Berardo's extensive collection of over 900 works includes pieces by pop art-influenced Italian painter Valerio Adami, the late British painter and photographer Eileen Agar and American minimalist sculptor Carl Andre. Tonight we have dinner at a local restaurant.

### **SUNDAY, DECEMBER 30**

We embark on a journey to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of **Sintra**, renowned for its 19<sup>th</sup>-century Romantic architectural monuments. We stop at the 18<sup>th</sup>-century **Queluz Palace**, often referred to as the "Portuguese Versailles" with its detailed fountains and statues surrounding one of Europe's last Rococo buildings. After lunch in Sintra we visit **Pena Palace**, arguably Sintra's best known castle, where our guide helps us explore the colorful and eclectic architecture of this storybook building. It was erected in honor of King Ferdinand and designed with characteristics similar to Bavaria's iconic Neuschwanstein Castle. After our visit we return to Lisbon where you are free to enjoy dinner on your own.

### **MONDAY, DECEMBER 31 (NEW YEAR'S EVE)**

After breakfast we tour the **Gulbenkian Museum**, one of the world's great museums and one of Europe's unsung treasures. Part of the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation, it houses a magnificent collection of Egyptian, Greek, Roman, Islamic, Asian and European art along with paintings by masters such as Rembrandt, Manet, Monet, Renoir and Cassat. We see the **Nations Park** area where the futuristic architecture of Eastern Lisbon is a complete contrast to the city's old quarters. Most of it was built by innovative architects for Expo 98, the World's Fair that took place in Portugal's capital in 1998. You are free for lunch and the afternoon. Choose to spend your time visiting the state-of-the-art **Oceanarium**, hailed as the world's most impressive aquarium or return to the hotel and explore the nearby shops or rest before our evening's festivities. Tonight we will celebrate the arrival of the New Year with a **Gala Dinner**. Details for this evening are a "work-in-progress."
